Old Vines Milagros 900 mt.



Lieu-Dit

Eternauta expresses the traditional Ribera del Duero format, using old vineyards with a diversity of varieties.

This high altitude site is composed of two plots where the clay-limestone soils stand out.

The plots that make up this site were planted between 1940 and 1950, in the usual style of the time, complementing Tinta Fina with Garnacha and other minority varieties.

Composition

Tinta Fina (and minority varieties).

Milagros: A site composed of two plots with eastern and northern exposure respectively, with deep clay-limestone soils. They provide a beautiful aromatic intensity of red fruits and elegant structure.

Harvest 2021

The 2021 vintage was one of the freshest in recent years. Ripening was slow and leisurely, leaving an aromatic intensity of fresh fruit and high levels of acidity. Harvested on October 2nd. Excellent health and low yields due to the age of the vines.

Winemaking

Harvest by hand, selection of bunches in the field. 40% whole bunch and the rest destemmed. Spontaneous fermentation (native yeasts) Malolactic fermentation in barrels Aged 12 months in used 225-liter barrels, plus 2 months in stainless steel before bottling Bottling without fining or filtering

Composition

Varietal: Tinta Fina (and minority varieties). Alcohol: 14% vol.
