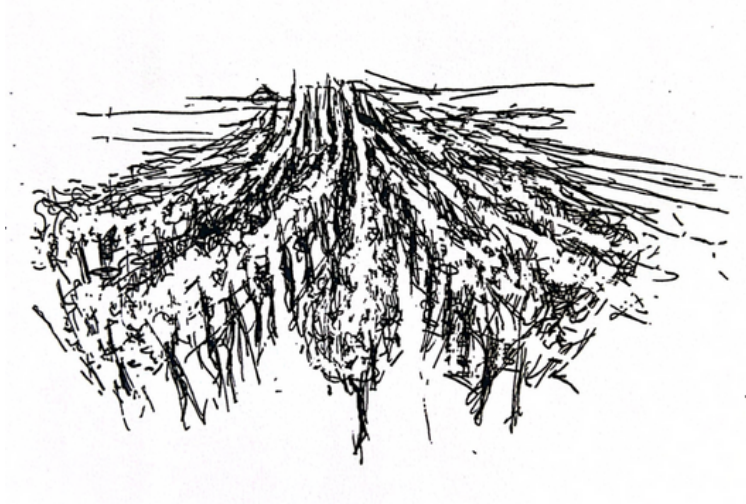




## PÁRPADOS 2021

## REGIONAL WINE

Parpados is our attempt to represent the essence of Ribera del Duero: high altitude vineyards on calcareous soils. The typical white soils of Burgos give our wines elegant and direct profiles.

The altitude of the area helps to mitigate the effects of the hot Castilian summers, in addition to generating fresher wines.

We accompany our plots with low-intervention vinification to reinforce the identity of the origin.



## **PÁRPADOS 2021** **HIGH ALTITUDE WINE**

### **Composition**

100% Tempranillo

Olmedillo de Roa: Hillside at 860 meters above sea level, with markedly limestone soils. It provides minerality and marked varietal expression.

Moradillo de Roa: Plot in plateau at 985 meters above sea level, composed of sand and limestone, with a stony surface. It provides greater tannic structure and aromatic intensity.

### **Harvest 2021**

The 2021 vintage was one of the freshest in recent years. Ripening was slow and leisurely, leaving an aromatic intensity of fresh fruit and high levels of acidity. Harvested on October 1 and 2. Excellent health and medium yields.

### **Winemaking**

Manual harvesting, selection of clusters in the field.  
Destemming  
Spontaneous fermentation (native yeasts)  
Malolactic fermentation in barrels  
Aging 12 months in used barrels of 225 and 500 liters.  
plus 2 months in stainless steel tanks prior to bottling.  
Bottling without fining or filtering

### **Composition**

Varietal: 100% Tempranillo

Alcohol: 14% vol.
